

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Purpose:

To recognize and support an active outstanding College or University student who is a member or relative of a member of the Alabama Vegetation Management Society, and to promote education and leadership within the organization.

Award Recognition:

The scholarship recipient will be selected by a committee of AVMS Board Members, appointed by the President, and will receive the following:

- · A certificate commemorating the award
- \$1,500.00 scholarship
- An invitation to attend the Annual Conference

Eligibility:

At the time of application, the applicant must be enrolled in or accepted to an accredited College or University within the State of Alabama and be a current member in good standing, or related to a current member in good standing, of the Alabama Vegetation Management Society. The applicant must be an enrolled undergraduate in September directly following the semester in which the scholarship is to be awarded. Applicants who have previously earned a B.S., B. A., or equivalent degree are **not** eligible for this award.

Selection Criteria:

Scholastic Performance (50%)

Diversity and difficulty of course work taken, grade point average, significant honors awards and achievements, and membership in Honor Societies.

Leadership and Extracurricular Activities (25%)

Participation in recognized clubs and organizations, elected offices, committees, projects and honors/awards for leadership in extracurricular activities.

Personal Traits (25%)

Evidence of good personal traits such as character, ethics, dependability, innovation and a strong work ethic. The applicant should include information regarding work experiences, honors, awards or activities that reflect these traits.

Application:

The completed application form and a personal photograph must be submitted to the Chair of the AVMS Scholarship Committee by the 1st of May in the year in which the scholarship is to be awarded.
